

FEES FOR DIVORCE IN GEORGIA

Effective July 1, 2024

<u>Uncontested</u>	\$1,000 + Filing Fees (up to 3 hours atty time) First 3 hours are discounted Atty time is billable after 3 hours at \$400/hour.	\$2,000 + Filing Fees (up to 6 hours atty time) First 6 hours are discounted Atty time is billable after 6 hours at \$400/hr.
<u>Contested</u>	\$400/hour (Minimum Retainer \$4,000 representing 10 hours) + Filing Fees	\$400/hour (Minimum Retainer \$6,000 representing 15 hours) + Filing Fees

It is impossible to predict precisely how many hours a contested divorce will require, as each client and each case is unique. Your retainer may vary, depending upon the facts specific to your case and the predicted level of dispute between you and your spouse.

Minimum retainers must be paid at the onset of attorney representation. This firm does not offer payment plans for retainers.

If your representation requires hours billed beyond those covered by your retainer, Mr. Lawler will notify you that your retainer has been depleted and estimate how many hours are anticipated to complete your case. You will be expected to replenish the retainer within one month of said notification.
